HOMEBOUND TUTORING SERVICES

A student may receive educational services at home, in a hospital or other setting because he or she is unable to attend school due to a medical condition. When an eligible student has a medical condition that will cause an absence for two or more consecutive weeks of school then the student shall be considered for home/hospital services.

The amount of instructional time shall not be less than 5 hours per week unless a physician has certified in writing that the student should not receive that amount of instruction in a school week. Instructional time shall be scheduled only on days when school is in regular session. Homebound tutoring must be renewed every eight weeks, with a doctor's certification.

Services may begin when the completed Request for Homebound/Hospital Instruction Form has been returned to the Student Services Office, via the student's Guidance Counselor. The Request must include a parent or guardian signature, the physician's name, address, phone number, signature and medical reason for and length of absence from school.
