## **DISTRICT PROFILE 2011-2012**

Hinsdale Township High School District 86 is located approximately 17 miles west of Chicago's Loop and is home to a concentration of professional/executive/managerial families, major corporate headquarters and commercial centers. The district is comprised of two high schools; Hinsdale Central and Hinsdale South. The two schools serve the suburbs of Oak Brook, Burr Ridge, Clarendon Hills, Hinsdale, Darien, Willowbrook and portions of Westmont.

- Finances:** Operating Expense per pupil (2010-2011) \$16,683  
2011-12 BA Step 1 salary \$51,743 (includes Board paid TRS)  
2011-12 MA+60 Step 19 salary \$124,714 (includes Board paid TRS)
- Faculty:** Over 380 full-time and part-time faculty and administrators. Approximately 88% have a master's degree or beyond; 8 hold doctorate degrees; 16 are nationally board certified; and approximately 24% have more than 20 years of teaching experience.
- Student Enrollment:** 4572 students
- Curriculum:** Comprehensive curriculum including over 50 Honors courses and over 40 Advanced Placement courses. The District supports a fully inclusive environment for all students.
- Extra-curricular:** Over 30 sports with competition at all levels; over 100 clubs and specialty activities; 85% of the student body is involved in at least one club/activity.
- Testing Results:** Hinsdale Township High School District ACT composite: 24.7  
86% of students scored 3 or higher on Advanced Placement Tests  
21 National Merit Finalists (Class of 2011)
- Post-Graduation:** 97.5% of District graduates attend 2-year or 4-year college programs
- Classroom Technology:** Every teacher has a Tablet PC and LCD projector for classroom use. Faculty and staff utilize Microsoft SharePoint 2007 Learning Management System for delivering instructional content. Each school is a completely wireless environment and has both tablet classroom labs and traditional desktop labs.
- Professional Development:** Extensive professional growth opportunities both in and out of the District. Largely relying on District teacher experts, professional development focuses on expanding online and traditional instructional methodologies.
- Recognition:** Hinsdale Central and Hinsdale South were recently ranked 7<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> in the state respectively by The Washington Post's "The High School Challenge." District 86 earned SchoolSearch 2011 Bright A+ Award for Academic Excellence in Education, SchoolSearch 2011 Bright Red Apple Award, and the Certificate of Excellence in Financial Reporting Award from the Association of School Business Officials for the 16<sup>th</sup> consecutive year. District 86 is an Energy Star Partner with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and was awarded an Environmental Stewardship Award from Energy Education.
