

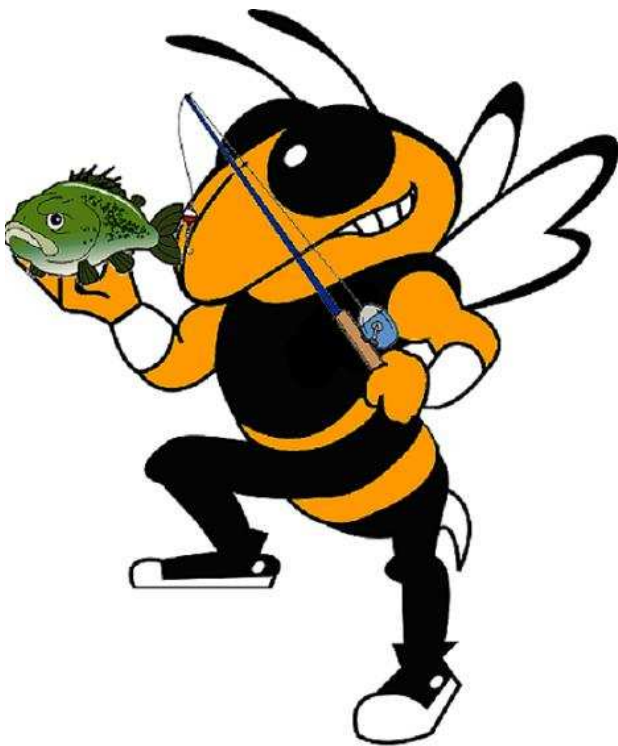
Overview of IHSA Bass Fishing
