Hinsdale Central won its fourth straight championship, outdistancing Elk Grove 120 points to 110. These two teams were followed closely by Hersey, Rolling Meadows and Niles North. The Hinsdale Central Red Devils were paced by Steve Shephard on Floor Exercise, Chuck Walters and Curt Rogers on pommel horse, Jim Erwin on parallel bars and Doug Wood on rings. The second place Elk Grove Grenadiers were lead by Scott Phillips (voted outstanding senior gymnast by the I.H.S.G.C.A.) on parallel bars, Bob Siemianowski on pommel horse, the trampoline trio of Steve Torgersen, Dave Hadley and Dave Khoshiba and finally by Jack Henry on still rings. This meet was one of the most exciting because this year there were three teams who could have taken the crown. Hinsdale Central, Elk Grove and Hersey all scored in the high 140's during the dual meet season.

Second only to the team championship for excitement was the battle for all-around honors. Mike Godawa of Rolling Meadows put on a dazzling display on the five events and came up with a score of 41.20 pts. He also took a third on horizontal bar, a third on parallel bars and a third on still rings. By the way, Mike is
